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BY-LAW 8 - CAMPING OR BUSHWALKING PERMIT APPLICATION

(Please allow 5 working days to process this permit)
Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation By-Laws

Pursuant to By-law 8 of the Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation By-laws, the Parks and Wildlife Commission of the Northern Territory ("the Commission") hereby grants to the party specified herein as the Permit Holder together with those persons specified herein as accompanying the Permit Holder ("the participants") a permit to camp at the location in the Park or Reserve specified herein subject to the payment of the fee or royalty and subject to the conditions specified herein:

CONDITIONS

The Permit Holder shall comply with all the terms and conditions which appear on the reverse side of this Permit.
A Certificate of Currency will need to be provided by all clubs, businesses, companies and associations prior to issuing the Permit (as per Condition 2 (b)).

CONDITIONS

In consideration of the Commission granting to the Permit Holder a By-law 8 Permit the Permit Holder hereby agrees as follows:

1. The Permit Holder together with the Participants enter the Park/Reserve entirely at their own risk and the Commission and the Conservation Land Corporation ("the Corporation") accept no liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, injury of whatsoever nature to the Permit Holder or to any other person arising out of or in connection with the presence of the Permit Holder or the Participants on the Park or Reserve.
2. The Permit Holder shall:
 - (a) indemnify, and keep indemnified the Corporation, the Northern Territory of Australia ("the Territory"), the Commission and its employees and agents against all claims, demands, loss or damage to property or injury to or death to any person arising as a result of or in connection with:
 - (i) the breach by the Permit Holder or the neglect or failure of the Permit Holder to observe or perform and fulfil any of the conditions contained herein; or
 - (ii) any activity of the Permit Holder or the Participants while on the Park or Reserve.
 - * (b) (i) effect and keep effected a comprehensive "all risks" liability policy inclusive of public liability and claims arising out of this Permit extended to include the Commission in any single event not less than ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) which policy shall be endorsed to include the indemnity given by the Permit Holder herein.
(ii) provide evidence to the Commission that such insurance has been effected.
 - (c) If so directed by the Commission, reimburse the Commission for any cost of search or rescue incurred by the Commission arising out of or in connection with the presence of the Permit Holder or the Participants on the Park or Reserve.
 - (d) comply with and shall ensure that the Participants comply with all regulations or rules made by the Commission and all Statutes, By-laws and Regulations in force in the Northern Territory in respect of the Park or Reserve.
 - (e) ensure all Participants are aware of the conditions of this Permit.
 - (f) not deviate from the plan attached hereto.
 - (g) take adequate equipment which shall include a first aid kit, water, food and navigation materials to safely complete the proposed walk.
 - (h) not drive nor permit to be driven any vehicle within the Park or Reserve other than on the designated roads or on such other areas as the Ranger-in-Charge or the Commission may approve.
 - (i) ensure that nothing is left in the Park or Reserve which, in the opinion of the Commission, may constitute a fire hazard, health hazard or a danger to persons, plants or animals.
 - (j) not camp or permit those accompanying the Permit Holder to camp otherwise than in the nominated camping areas. The Permit Holder is permitted to camp at the places indicated above and in the vicinity of but not within a two (2) kilometre radius of:
 - (i) public carparks and roads;
 - (ii) intensive use walking trails.
 - (k) not light any fires nor permit any fires to be lit other than in portable stoves or Commission approved fireplaces or as otherwise approved by the Ranger in Charge.
 - (l) obey all reasonable directions given by an officer of the Commission.
 - (m) not do nor permit to be done anything in the Park or Reserve which is noisome, offensive or a nuisance or annoyance to other users of the Park or Reserve.
 - (n) where toilet facilities are not available ensure that all faeces and paper are buried.
 - (o) ensure that all refuse and litter is removed from the Park or Reserve by the expiration of this Permit.
 - (p) carry this Permit at all times while on the Park or Reserve.
 - (q) notify a Ranger when the Permit Holder and the Participants have returned.
3. This Permit shall not confer upon the Permit Holder or the Participants the exclusive right to possession of the whole or any part of the Park or Reserve.
4. This Permit shall be automatically revoked by the Commission if in the opinion of the Commission any of the above conditions are breached by the Permit Holder.

A Certificate of Currency will need to be provided by all clubs, businesses, companies and associations prior to issuing the permit as per Condition 2 (b).
